

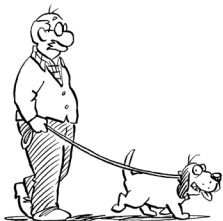
More Information for Walkers

The scenic two-mile walk route is on a paved path surrounding the 77-acre lake. Water stations will be set up along the walk route. Rest stations are located nearby.

The Walk will be rain or shine, so please dress for the weather.

Your canine friends and other pets who would safely be able to do the walk with you are welcome. The park regulations require that they be leashed at all times except for in the dog park area. You will need to clean up after your friend (plastic bags will be available). All animals must have current rabies vaccines. Please do not bring female dogs in heat. Your feline friends and puppies under 6 months of age may be happier at home. A nice way to include them might be to bring or wear a photo of your pet.

Be sure to join us for the post-walk festivities. They will include music, entertainment, refreshments, prizes, free samples and an opportunity to enjoy the beautiful park and your fellow walker's company.



Tips for Successful Walkers

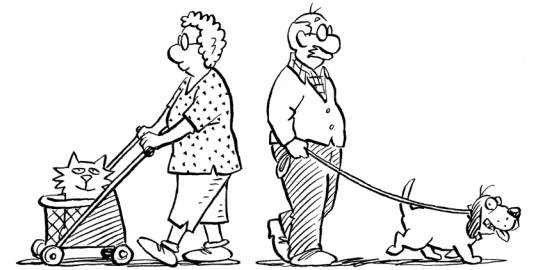
- Set a \$\$ goal for yourself and ask sponsors to help you reach it.
